



Members' Day Frequently Asked Questions

I'm a WPC member. May I bring a guest?

Yes! We encourage you to bring guests and appreciate your help in introducing new friends to WPC. Bring as many guests as you like. We ask that you RSVP by April 24th.

Can I attend part of the day, rather than the entire day?

Yes! The day's activities are free for members (except for the buffet lunch), so enjoy as much of the event as your schedule allows.

Is the event handicapped-accessible?

The Barn and Visitor Center have handicapped-accessible parking and restroom facilities. The Barn is two levels and does not have an elevator. All information sessions are held on the first floor and the buffet is served on the second level, which is accessed from a crushed gravel driveway. Staff can provide a shuttle to the second level on request.

Are there any activities for children?

We love seeing kids at Members' Day! They can enjoy hands-on activities and participate in a morning nature bioblitz and family hikes. Please note that children age 6 and older can tour Fallingwater.

Is there any cost involved?

Members' Day is a wonderful, affordable outing for families. **The activities and Fallingwater tours are free.** A free continental breakfast is available from 8 a.m. to 10 a.m.

If you'd like to join us for a plentiful lunch buffet, the cost is \$18 per adult and free for children 10 and under. **Lunch reservations are required by April 24th.** You're also welcome to bring your own picnic.



Can I purchase the buffet lunch the day of the event?

Lunch reservations are required by April 24th. If you're not sure you want to pack your own picnic, please pre-register for the lunch buffet.

How do I make reservations to tour Fallingwater on Members' Day?

Please refer to the schedule of events to plan your day. You can schedule your tour in advance by calling Visitor Services at 724-329-8501, or register the morning of the event in the Upper Barn. Free shuttles to and from Fallingwater are provided all day.

What's on the lunch buffet menu? Does it include vegetarian options?

Yes. Vegetarian and gluten free options are available, including a protein. You may also choose from all-beef hot dogs, kielbasa, chicken, vegetarian baked beans, gluten free/dairy free pasta, salads and cookies for dessert.

I would enjoy going on a hike. How difficult are they?

We will have guided walks and hikes suited for all fitness levels. These treks range from meandering nature walks for the casual stroller to rugged trails for the experienced hiker. *But please note,* Bear Run Nature Reserve is hilly and any forest path can be uneven – use your best judgement on your ability to hike these trails.

What should I wear to the event?

This is a casual, fun day – no need to dress up! Comfortable clothing and walking shoes are best. A rain jacket and hat are recommended if the weather forecasts a wet day.
